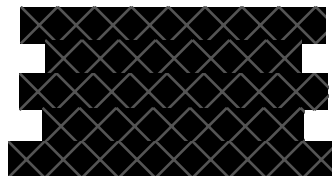
### **Plans for the Bride and Groom**
